

WPA's Open Letter to WHO



World Patient Safety Day 2025:

Patient Safety from the Start



WPA joins the WHO's global call to action for World Patient Safety Day 2025, set to be marked on 17 September with the theme "Safe care for every newborn and every child" and the slogan "Patient safety from the start!" This year's theme highlights the urgent need to protect infants and children from preventable harm in healthcare especially in vulnerable settings such as neonatal and paediatric intensive care units.

Like every year, WPA will launch a massive global campaign to mobilize its members, partners, and stakeholders to raise awareness, share knowledge, and promote safer care practices for children across all health systems.

WPA Signs Strategic Collaboration with Platform Worldwide


